

*Chapman, John G.* Senator appeared 40. Elected President of the Senate 55-6, leave of absence granted 188, returned 223.

Resolution unanimously adopted, presenting the thanks of the Senate for the able, courteous and impartial manner in which he presided over the deliberations of the body 347.

*Charles County.* A further supplement to the act to authorise the levy court of, to assess and levy a sum of money on the assessable property thereof, for the purpose of building a goal in, passed Nov. Ses. 1811, chap. 55, received and referred 214, favorably reported on, passed and returned to the House of Delegates 329.

*Chase, Samuel.* Resolution requiring the Governor to have a full length likeness made of the late Samuel Chase, William Paca and Thomas Stone, received and referred 307, favorably reported on 327, assented to and returned to the House of Delegates 341.

*Chesapeake and Delaware Canal.* Message proposing a joint committee to proceed to Delaware, and urge upon the legislature, the adoption of some measure for the relief of our citizens from the onerous exactions and serious inconveniencies experienced by them, in trading through 142, message adopted in answer declining 146, order directing the committee on judicial proceedings to enquire into the nature and extent of the grievances complained of, and to report, 146.

*Chesapeake and Ohio Canal.* Resolution regulating the tolls of, received and referred 215, favorably reported on, assented to and returned to the House of Delegates 319.

*Chesapeake and Ohio Canal, and Baltimore and Susquehanna Rail Road.* A bill for the completion of, to Cumberland, and York, received and referred 225, reported with amendments 276-7 8-9, made the order
