

Elkton Bank. Leave to report a supplement to the act to establish a Bank and incorporate a company, under the name of the Elkton Bank of Maryland, granted and referred 208, bill reported 210, ordered to be engrossed 218-19, passed 232, sent to the House of Delegates 234-5, returned "will pass" 343.

Elkton Library Company. Petition of sundry inhabitants of Elkton for the incorporation of a Library Company in Elkton, presented and referred 78, bill reported to incorporate, ordered to be engrossed, passed, and sent to the House of Delegates 127, returned "will pass" 175.

Ellicott's Old Upper Mills. A supplement to the act to authorise the repair of the bridge over the Patapsco at, received and referred 184, favorably reported on 196, passed and returned to the House of Delegates 197.

Ellicott Street. Petition of Andrew and John Ellicott for a law to transfer to them a portion of Balderston Street, in consideration of their allowing the extension of Ellicott Street to, presented and referred 82, unfavorably reported on, concurred in 154.
