- Salem Church.* A bill received for the relief of the General Reformed Lutheran Congregation of Salem Church in Boonsborough in Washington county, referred 51, favorably reported on, passed and returned to the House of Delegates 56.
- Sale of Intoxicating Liquors.* A bill received to prohibit the sale of, on the Sabbath Day, referred 305, favorably reported on, passed and returned to the House of Delegates 330.
- Salisbury* A bill received to regulate the sale of ardent spirits within the village of, in Somerset and Worcester Counties. referred 164, favorably reported on, passed and returned to the House of Delegates 167.
- Sappington, Thomas.* Senator appeared 3. Elected President of the Senate vice B. S Forrest, resigned 6, announced his determination to retire from the chair at the close of the session of that day 54, order presenting the thanks of the Senate, for the ability and courtesy with which he discharged the duties of the chair 65; appointed President *pro tem.* 188.
- Savage Coal and Iron Company of Allegany county.* A bill received to incorporate, referred 185, favorably reported on 210, amendments proposed 211, amendments dissented from and the bill passed 221, returned to the House of Delegates 224.
