A bill entitled, an act to alter and change the name of Thomas Dawson of Dorchester county, to the name of Thomas McKinsie.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Page, Osborne and Montgomery.

Mr. Morris from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, a supplement to the act entitled, an act to incorporate the Govans Town Academy in Baltimore county, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second and by special order the third time and passed.
