

Strike out the preamble of the bill.

Strike out the words "in Cecil county," in the second line of the bill.

Strike out the words "Cecil county" in fifth line and substitute the words "their respective counties."

Amend the title of the bill by striking out the words "in Cecil county and for other purposes."

The bill was then read the second and by special order the third time, passed, and returned to the House of Delegates.
