

Then was read the Bill for Causes testamentary
as it is recorded 12 August 1643

Then the Bill for the plenty of Corn

Then was the house adjourned by Consent till 2
of the Clock afternoon

Richard Jarnett appointed for his Proxy Mr
Tho Greene

22 March 1643

in the afternoon

Assembled the greater Part the Company as
afore

The Committee reported to the house that upon
examining the petition of John Medley the Comi-
denced that John Hallows should deliver at St
Marys before the end of May next 4 Bine with 4
Cades John Medley paying to John Hallows in
view of finding a Boat for the transport of them
200 tobacco with Cash on or afore the 10th November
next and in default of such delivery at or afore
the said day the said Hallows should pay to John
Medley on the said 10th November five thousand wth
Tobacco with Cash

And the house approved and confirmed the said
Judgment of the Committee

Then was a petition presented by David Wick-
liff in the name of the Protestant Catholics of Mary-
land respited till the next morning

And the house adjourned it self till the next morning
