An Act for the setting this present House of Assembly

Be it enacted by the Lord Proprietary of and with the advice and assent of the freemen of the Province that his Lordships Council present in the Province and these sixteen Persons Captain John Rice Captain Robert Vaughan W^m Fenwick W^m Bradnor W^m Conner W^m Thornborough W^m Brooks Thomas Allen Richard Banks Barnaby Jackson George Saphyer George Usherick John Medley Walter Martin Walter Pakes Edward Packer or any ten of them assembled with the Governor and the clerk of the Assembly at the time and place prefixed by the said Governor shall be a house of Assembly to all intents and Purposes and all Bills passed by the said freemen or the Major part of them and enacted by the Governor shall be Law after publication thereof under the hand of the Governor and present seal of the Province as fully to all Effects in Law as if they were advised and assented unto by all the freemen of the Province in Person
