

Upon the demand aforesaid Mark Theype Attorney of
 W^m Hartford Administrator of the Estate of W^m Weston

 duced in the Assembly and a letter of Thomas Weston under
 his own hand acknowledging the debt which Schievan
 specialty appear upon record acknowledge 135 principal

 he had not Effects enough in his hands wherewith to discharge
 the said debt demanded and the house adjudged 21600^{to}
 tobacco at the rate of 1²/₃ to the Administrator allow house doctored
 to the house that the Administrator had the Acc^t of the Estate
 with him and he himself had it not and therefore allowed
 two months liberty to give notice to the Administrator in Vir-
 ginia that he may bring in his acc^t and that till that time
 no Execution may issue against the personall Estate

The Administrator Attorney acknowledged upon
 demand that he had sufficient personal estate in his hands
 to discharge other Precedent dues out of the Estate the house
 Ordered that the Plaintiff might immediately have an ac-
 cent upon the lands of the said Thomas Weston but that
 the Defendants Request concerning no execution to be issued
 against the personal estate until the two months demanded
 be expired should be granted him
