

Saturday the 21<sup>st</sup> of April 1649 being the last day and Sessions day of the Assembly

The house being called all assembled but Mr Pile and Mr Hutton whose absence was excused by the Governor

The Committee brought in the charge of this present Assembly which was followeth viz

At the Committee for Charge of the Assembly the Committee appointed the sum underwritten to be paid to the Parties underwritten this 21<sup>st</sup> of April 1649
