Be it Enacted by the Lord Proprietor
 with the Advice and Assent of this Hon-
 ourable Court, that whosoever shall wrongfully
 Kill, or carry away any marked Swine
 or other man's shall be double the
 value of such Swine to the owner thereof
 And two hundred Pounds of Tobacco
 to him that shall inform thereof, and
 three hundred Pounds more for a fine
 to the Lord Proprietary to be paid out of
 offenders Estate or Goods. And in case an
 one offending however shall not be found
 able to satisfy such Offence as aforesaid
 such person shall be censured & punished
 as the Governor and Council shall think fit
 in Court or other Judge shall thinke fit
 And whosoever shall know of any such
 hegg or Hoggs stolen, and shall not reveale
 the same forthwith to the Constable of his
 Hundred where he is residing shall
