An Act concerning Drunkenness.

9. Be it Enacted by the Lord Proprietary
by and with the Consent of this present
Generall Assembly that hee that shall be
lawfully convicted of Drunkenness by two
sufficient Witnesses shall for the first offence
be sett in the stocks Six hours, or pay one
hundred pounds of Tobacco, halfe to the
Informers, the other halfe to the Lord Pro-
prietary. For the second offence being con-
victed as aforesaid to be publicly whipt
or pay three hundred pounds of Tobacco as
aforesaid. Being the third time convicted
as aforesaid, the Offender shall be adjudged a
Person infamous, and thereby made uncap-
able of giving vote, or bearing Office within
this Province during the space of three years
next after such Conviction. This Act to con-
tinue for three years, or to the End of the next
Generall Assembly, and no longer.
