An Act concerning Ferries

Whereas the Inconvenience now for want of
Ferries in this Province is so burdensome
to the Country, Be it Enacted by the Lord
Proprietary by and with the Consent of the
present Generall Assembly that Every
County within this Province shall main-
tain one Ferry (the County of Kent only
Excepted) which Ferry shall be left to the
County Court to appoint where it is most
necessary to be kept and to assign the said
County for providing a Boate and satisfy-
ing the Ferryman. And whatsoever done
shall be done in the premises after
the last of August next shall be void to
the Lord Proprietary one thousand
pounds off Tobacco. This Act to continue
for three years or to the End of the
Generall Assembly and no longer
