

And be it further Enacted that every Master
 or Assignee or Trustee of what kind
 for ever owning or keeping any such Servant ac-
 cording to the Statute in that behalf made
 shall within six months next after the receiving of the said Servant into their
 custody within this Province except he sue on his
 behalf within four years Service of such Servant
 being by the said Servant the said Servant into their
 custody in any County Court where they do inhabit and
 every of the said Courts are here by authorized to
 Judge of and determine the age of such Servant
 brought, and cause the same to be entered upon
 record And every Person as aforesaid neglecting
 refusing to bring such Servant or Servants before
 the Courts as aforesaid shall not only stand to the
 determination of the Court, but also suffer the penalty
 of one thousand pounds of Tobacco for depriving the
 Court of such opportunity of view of the party
 And if any Master or Servant aforesaid be aggrieved
 with the determination of the Court he shall within
 the time determined for their Service present an
 authentic Certificate of such Servants age and shall
 have Redress according to the age aforesaid mentioned
 And be it further Enacted by his authority aforesaid
 that no indenture made by any Servant during his
 Service due by former indenture or by determi-
 nation of the Court according to the Honor of this Act
 shall anywise obligate any Servant for longer time
 than by his first indenture or determination
 he shall be limited and appointed provided
 that his Master any thing therein to be bound
 shall not give or be construed to give any benefit
 any Slave or whatsoever this Act to endure for
 three years or the end of the next General
 Assembly
