Ordered Capt. Hill, Major Dent and Major Smithson prepare them
with all convenient speed.

Moved in ye House that whereas George Layfield Esq^r one of the Com^{rs} for
Somerset County hath unjustly charged the said County for attending the County
Court when at ye same tyme he was not in ye County.

Ordered that ye Sheriffs of Somerset County have ye said Layfield^s
before this House upon the next Sessions or Meeting.

The House adjourned till two of ye Clocke.
