the same which shall discharge such Treasurers.

Major Hamonds and Major Dent sent to His Maty. Hon^{ble} Councill
with a certain Bill, read and assented to by the House for the payment of
154^l 5^s 3^d according to the Resolve of this House.

They are also Ordered to acquaint His Ex^{ty} that this House is ready to
attend him in Order to compleate this Business.

Major Hamond and Major Dent returne to the House and say that
they have delivered their Messages and bring downe the Bill last sent
up to the Councill assented to by that Hon^{ble} Board, and acquaintes the
House that His Ex^{ty} is ready to Receive them in the Councill Chamber.

Whereupon Mr. Speaker and the Members of this House go up to His
Ex^{ty} the Gov^r and being admitted.

Mr. Speaker presents to His Ex^{ty} the following Bills for His assent.

Stadt. House in the Towne or port of Annapolis shall be appointed.

An Act for Reformation of Profanes in Maryland.

An Act for Quieting the differences arising between the Indians and
English private Controversies.

An Act for the Naturalization of Stephen Francis an Italian and George
Hecombe a German borne.

An Act certaining what shall be the Sheriffs duty in and upon lettings
by them made for publicke dues and officers fees.

An Act for apportioning the publicke Levy.

An Act for payment of 154^l 5^s 3^d -

To which His Ex^{ty} was pleased on His Maty. behalfe to assent to
and the same were sealed with the Broad Seale of this Province.
