The Honble Tho^s Tench and Charles Hutchins Esq^{rs} Enter the house and bring back y^e bill sent by Col^l Thompson's assented to by the Council.

Ordered that Mr^s Sand^{rs} Young Mr^s Mich^{ls} Miller, Mr^s Walter Cambell and Mr^s Walter Lane goe and Informe his Exc^t that there is not any further business Lys before this house.

Voted that an humble address be Drawne to his May^{ty} for to Returne him humble thanks for his Care in sending us his Most Excellency Nathaniell Blackistone Gov^r to Rule over us and that Mr^s Speaker signe the Same on behalfe of the whole house.

Major W^m Dent his May^{ty} Mr^s Gent^l Enter the house and Informes Mr^s Speaker that his Exc^t Commands him and the whole house to attend him at the Council Chambers to compleate this Sessions of Assembly.

Mr^s Speaker and the house goe to the Council Chamber at the Council Chamber.

Mr^s Speaker Presented to his Exc^t the severall Bills made this Sessions as alsoe the severall Laws which were Continued in force being newly transcribed to which his Exc^t was pleased to give his assent thereto by Endorsing y^e Same with these words. Viz.

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On the Behalfe of his Most Sacred May^{ty} King William the third by the Grace of God of England Scotland France and Ireland &c. I will these to be Laws.

Which Being done his Exc^t was pleased to Seale the Same with the Broad Seale of this Province which Laws being doe signed and Sealed his Exc^t was pleased to acquaint this house that he thought it Convenient for his Maty^{ty} Service to Prorogue them untill the Twenty eighth day of October next and that they were thereby accordingly Prorogued.

And Soe Ended this Sessions of Assembly.
