- 3 An Act ascertaining the Gauges of Tobacco hogsheads and to prevent Copping
 Cutting and defacing Tob^o. taken on Board Shippes and Vessels upon
 Freight
- 4 An Act to reforme the ill practice of High Sheriffs within this Province
- 5 An Act reviving and continuing an Act of Assembly in this Province
 intituled an Act for the Ordering and regulating the Militia of this
 Province for the better security and defence thereof and for the supply-
 ing some defects therein
- 6 An Act reviving an Act intituled An Act for limitation of Officers fees
- 7 An Act to revive continue and make good and Valid in Law all process
 and proceedings in S^t. Marys County Court, from the eighth Day of June
 this present year to the first Tuesday of November ensuing
- 8 An Act for payment and Assesment of the publick Charge of this Provin-
- 9 An Act confirming and making good and effectual in Law a certain Bond
 or release made by Susannah Tracy wife of Tho. Tracy, of Ann Arund
 County Carpenter to James Heath of Queen Anns County Gent.
- 10 An Act empowering Thomas Edmondson of Talbot County surviving
 of his father John Edmondson to sell and dispose of the Lands by the said
 Edmondson left for the payment of his Debts
- 11 An Act for Naturalization of David Pagott of Queen Anns County planter
 and Maudlin his wife and their Children
- 12 An Act confirming to Major Hawkins and Henry Wright of Queen
 Anns County certain Lands therein mentioned
