

Four of their Members *Justices* ordered by the House that the Sheriff of Baltimore County immediately on receipt hereof returne according to the Petition Speaker of the House the Counter parts of the Indentures for the said Delegates and that the Sheriff of Ann Arundell County immediately give the Sheriff of Baltimore County with this Order who is commanded to comply therewith or stand his refusal to the contrary.

Thomas Ennals petition read and referred to the Committee of Laws to examine the petition's pretensions and allegations and report their opinion therein to the House.

Col^l Ennals, Col^l Tughman, Col^l Addison and Sam^l Young Esq from the Council enter the House and deliver Mr Speaker the following Messages and severall papers therein mentioned viz.

By the President and Council in Assembly 8th 28th 1753.
Gent. We have herewith sent you her Majesty's Commands in her Letter of the 20th of October 1752. and her order in Council of the 30th of March 1750. in favour of S^r Thomas Lawrence Barr^r her Maty's Secretary of this Province and earnestly recommend to you to demonstrate your Duty and regard to her Most Sacred Majesty by your due Consideration thereof and ready Compliance with her Commands and directions therein Express.

Order the following Message be sent to the Council

By the House of Delegates 8th 28th 1753.
We find by the Journall of our House in 9ber 1709 that we Address her Majesty in full Answer to S^r Thomas Lawrence's Complaint by any thing app^o by her Maty's last order this Day transmitted us we cannot find the same was ever presented to her Majesty we desire your Hon^os to inform us if ever they were transmitted to England.

The House adjourns till to Morrow Morning Thus a Week Thursday the 29th October 1753.
