 reported to by the House of Delegates. was sent up to the Council by Mr. Joseph
 Hill, and Mr. Joseph Gray for their Report. And they were ordered to acquaint
 his Excellency & Council that this House at present has nothing else before them
 so that if they have any thing^{to} more to impart the House are ready to proceed
 thereupon. They return & say they delivered their Message.
