Ordered by the House that Mr Joseph Gray and Mr John Jones desire the Rev<sup>d</sup> Mr Wootton to attend this House in the Morning at seven and Afternoon at five O'Clock for Divine Service.

The Gentleman desired to attend his Excellency on this House and say they delivered their Message and that his Excellency was pleased to say he will forthwith send for Mr Speaker and the whole House.

The House adjourned till to Morrow Morning seven O'Clock
