That his Excellency the Governor commands him and the whole House to attend him at the Council Chamber to see the Laws made this Session sealed, and his Excellency pass the Royal Assent thereto.

The House accordingly adjourns to the Council Chamber where Mr. Speaker presented the following Bills to his Excellency the Gov. for the Royal Assent to be given thereto viz:

A Bill for reviving and continuing an Act of Assembly of this Province Entituled an Act for the Ordering and regulating the Militia of this Province for the better Security and Defence thereof and for supplying some Defects therein.

A Bill for laying an Imposition of 3. Pence on Tolls for defraying the Charge of the Province.

A Bill for relieving the Inhabitants of this Province from some Aggravances in the Prosecution of Suits at Law.

A Bill reviving a certain Act of Assembly of this Province Entituled an Act for Limitation of Officers Fees and for supplying some Defects therein and also reviving another Act of Assembly of this Province Entituled an Act explaining some doubtful Expressions in the Act for Limitation of Officers Fees.

All and every of which said several Bills his Excellency the Gov. was pleased to Enact and make into Laws by sealing each of them with the great Seal of this Province and indorsing each of them in the following Manner viz:

July 3<sup>o</sup>. 1714 On Behalf of her Sacred Majesty Queen Ann of Great Britain &c. — I will this be a Law — John Hart

After which his Excellency the Gov. was pleased to declare that with the Advice of her Majesty's Honorable Council he thought fit to prorogue this General Assembly till the fifth Day of October next to which Time they were accordingly prorogued. Afterward Mr. Speaker with the Rest of the Members of the House of Delegates returned to their own House and then Mr. Speaker resumed the Chair and reported to the House that his Excellency the Gov. with the Advice of her Majesty's Honorable Council had prorogued this General Assembly till the fifth Day of October next to which Time this House prorogues itself.

So endeth this present Session of Assembly being the 3. Session on the 3. Day of July One thousand seven hundred and fourteen
