

That his Excellency the Governour commands him and the whole House to attend him at the Council Chamber to see the Laws made this Session Sealed.

And his Excellency read the Royall Assent thereto.

The House accordingly adjourns to the Council Chamber where Mr. Speaker presented the following Bills to his Excellency the Governour for the Royall Assent to be given thereto viz.

A Bill for Revising and Continuing an act of Assembly of this Province Intituled an Act for the Ordering and Regulating the Militia of this Province for the better Security and defence thereof and for supplying some Defects therein.

A Bill for relieving the Inhabitants of this Province from some Aggrievances in the Prosecution of Suits at Law.

A Bill for laying an Imposition of 3^d p^{ct}. on Tobacco for defraying the Charge of the Province.

A Bill reviving a certain act of Assembly of this Province Intituled an act for Limitation of officers Fees and for supplying some defects therein. And also reviving another act of Assembly of this Province Intituled an act Explaining some doubtful Expressions in the Act for Limitation of officers Fees.

All and every of which said General Bills his Excellency the Governour was pleased to enact and make into Laws by Sealing each of them with the Great Seale of this Province and Indorsing each of them in the following Manner, viz.
