

They returned and say they Delivered the same  
 Coll<sup>o</sup> Richard Seligman from the Honble Council into the  
 House and Delivered Mr<sup>r</sup> Speaker the  
 Engraved Bill for adjusting the publick Charge of this Province  
 and appointing a Committee to appropriation of same for this present  
 year one thousand seven hundred and fourteen -  
 thus Endorsed, viz<sup>t</sup> -

By the Council in asembly October 9<sup>th</sup> 1714  
 Read and reported to by her Majesty's Honble Council,  
 and - Signed for her, W. Bladen Esq<sup>r</sup> Council  
 and also acquainted him that his Excellency the Governour  
 requires him and the whole House to attend him in the printed  
 Chamber to see the said Law sealed and his Excellency pass the  
 Royall Assent thereto

The House accordingly adjourned to the Council Chamber  
 where Mr<sup>r</sup> Speaker presented the said Bill to his Excellency the  
 Governour for the Royall Assent to be given thereto, viz<sup>t</sup> -  
 A Bill for adjusting the publick Charge of this Province, and  
 appointing a Committee to appropriation the same for this present  
 year one thousand seven hundred and fourteen -  
 Which said Bill his Excellency the Governour was pleased  
 to enact into a Law by sealing the same with the great Seals  
 of this Province, and endorsing it in the following Manner  
 viz<sup>t</sup> -

October 9<sup>th</sup> 1714 On behalf of her Sacred Majesty  
 Queen Anne of Great Brittain &c -  
 I will this be a Law  
 Jo: Hart

After which his Excellency the Governour was pleased  
 to decree that with the advice of her Majesty's Honble  
 Council he thought fitt to prorogue this present Generall  
 Assembly till the tenth day of November next -  
 to which time they were accordingly prorogued

Afterwards Mr<sup>r</sup> Speaker with the rest of the Members  
 of the House of Delegates returned to their own House, and then  
 Mr<sup>r</sup> Speaker returned the Charge and

Reported to the House that his Excellency the Governour,  
 with the advice of her Majesty's Honble Council had prorogued  
 this Generall Assembly till the tenth day of November next,  
 to which time this House prorogues it selfe -  
 Soe Endeth this present Session of Assembly being the  
 on 9<sup>th</sup> Ninth day of October, one thousand seven hundred and fourteen -
