An Engrosed Bill for Repealing an Act of Assembly intitled an Act for uniting new part hundred now part of King and Queen Parish, to William and Mary Parish in Charles County for uniting the same to King & Queens Parish in St. M. City.

An Engrosed Bill for Making good and valid a Certain Indenture or Deed of Bargain and Sale from William Lum late of Ann Arundell County deed to Thomas Larkin Gent.

An Engrosed Bill to supply certain defects in Conveying Lands from Matthew Beards to Stephen Wright and from Stephen Wright to Jamell Chambers of Ann Arundell County Gent.

An Engrosed Bill for Naturalization of Thomas Harvey of Calvert County and his Children.

An Engrosed Bill for vesting in the Rector Gov<sup>r</sup> and Visitors of Free Schools and their Successors forever a certain Lot of Land in the City of Annapolis and an house thereon erected commonly called the Rectors house and empowering the said Rector Gov<sup>r</sup> and Visitors more easily to transact the business of the said Free Schools.

An Engrosed Bill to supply an Omission in the writing the last Will and Testament of Nathaniel Haywood late of St. Marys County deed and for settling an Estate of Inheritance in fee Simple on Robert Scott Clarke and Charles Beale Planter the Executors and devisees in the said Will named.

An Engrosed Bill for Relief of Ezekiel Carr of Cecil County.

An Engrosed Bill for Relief of Peter Sewell of Calvert County.
