 Gents

Wee inform you that notwithstanding the act of Assembly  
 for limitation of officers fees empowering the Governour & Council  
 to settle any officers fees not sufficiently provided for by that Law,  
 and that the Governour and his Majesty's Council had in pursuance  
 thereof taken care to settle the aforesaid fee of 480<sup>l</sup> to the Keeper  
 of the great Seal for the affixing the seal to the copy of laws made each  
 Session and sent to the County Courts, omitted in that Law, yet the  
 Justices of the severall County Courts have Refused to make allow-  
 ance thereof which we desire may be provided for by an Ordinance  
 this Session, and also that care be now taken to make sufficient  
 allowance to the Keeper of the great Seal for Transcribing the Laws  
 this Session -

 deration and debate of this house,

The Question was putt whether the 480<sup>l</sup> of the Seal be allowed to the  
 Keeper of the great Seal for the affixing that Seal to a Body of all the

 Transcribing of the Body of all the Laws made this Session for each
