Afterwards his Excellency was pleased to declare that with the advice  
of the right Honble of Lords Proprietors Council of State within this  
Province he thought fit to prorogue this present General Assembly  
till the seventh day of October next to which time the same was  
accordingly prorogued

Thereupon Mr. Speaker with the rest of the Members of this  
House return to their own house where Mr. Speaker assumes  
the Chair and reported to the House that his Excellency the Gov. with  
the advice of the right Honble the Lords Proprietors Council of State  
in this Province had prorogued this present General Assembly to  
the seventh day of October (next to which time this House  
accordingly prorogues itself)

To Endeth this third Session of a year held  
for this Province after his Majesty was graciously  
pleas'd to restore of Mr. Montagu of Lords Proprietors to this  
Province this tenth day of May Anno Domini 1718.
