- 1 Page in 8th Line between the words Exportation, and until, put any Indian Corn Wheat or other Grain
 - 2 Page 8th Line between words grain, and or, put Meal Flower or Bread
 - 3 Page 11th Line after the word grain, put Meal Flower or Bread -
 - 3 Page 8th Line after the word, or, put or Cause to be sold Bartered or otherwise disposed of
 - 4 Page 11th Line the words any such Wheat Indian Corn or other Grain Meal flower or bread to be sold out
 - 4 Page 1st Line after the word grain, add Meal Flower or Bread
 - 5 Page 5th Line after the word, District, put, and they are hereby Enjoyned and required
 - 6 Page 6th Line after the word Grain, add Meal Flower or Bread
 - 8 Page 8th Line after the word Grain add, Meal Flower or Bread
 - 5 Page 1st Line after the word Grain add Meal Flower or Bread
 - 3 Page 3rd Line after the word Informer put Owner or Proprietor thereof and after
the word act in the same Line add these words unless such Owner or Proprietor
or the Master of such Vessel shall or will Discover upon his or their Oath
or Oath the true and just Quantity of such wheat Indian Corn or other grain
Meal Flower or Bread and give good and sufficient Security to such Ward
or other Officer of the Customs Sheriff or Justice of Peace as aforesaid payed to
the Lord Proprietary with Condition to abide the Event and Determination
of such Seizure or Suit as shall be had therein -
