

The Ingrossed Bill entituled, *An Act for the dividing of certain Warehouses in Talbot County, therein named*; And

The Ingrossed Bill entituled, *An Act for the Continuation of Causes, and securing the Peace and good Government of this Province*;

Were severally passed into Laws by his Excellency the Governor, in the usual Manner, by sealing them with the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary his Great Seal at Arms, and Indorsing them thus;

“ On Behalf of the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary of this Province, I WILL THIS BE A LAW.”

His Excellency made the following Speech; *viz.*

Gentlemen of the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly,
THE Business of this Session being at an End, I have thought fit, with the Advice of his Lordship's Council of State, to prorogue this Assembly to the first Tuesday in *April* next; and you are to take Notice you are prorogued to that Day accordingly.

So endeth this first Session of Assembly, this Fourteenth Day of *December*, Anno Domini 1751.
