The Order of the Day being Read; the House took into Consideration the Petition of many Inhabitants near *Elk-Ridge* Landing, in *Anne-Arundel* County, praying to have a Town erected there; and, on Motion, the Question was put, Whether it was expedient to erect a Town at *Elk-Ridge* Landing, or not. RESOLVED in the Affirmative.

On Motion, ORDERED, That the Petition of many Inhabitants of *Elk-Ridge* Landing, be referred for further Consideration on the Morrow Morning, immediately after Call of the House.

The Order of the Day being Read; the House took into Consideration the Petition of many the Inhabitants near *Elk-Ridge* Landing, in *Anne-Arundel* County, and ORDERED, That the said Petition be Granted; and Leave given to bring in a Bill according to Prayer; ORDERED, That *Mr. J. Hall*, *Mr. J. Tilghman*, *Col. Tilghman*, *Mr. Johnson*, *Mr. Murdock*, *Mr. Key*, *Mr. Beall*, and *Mr. Worthington*, do prepare and bring in a Bill accordingly.

The Petition of the Rector, Vestrymen, Churchwardens, and Inhabitants of *Port-Tobacco* Parish, praying to have Leave to bring in a Bill to levy on the taxable Inhabitants of the said Parish, an additional Quantity of 2^{lb} of Tobacco per Poll, for the Support of an Organist, was Read and Rejected.

The Petition of the Rector, Churchwardens, Vestrymen, and Others, of *St. John's* Parish in *Prince-George's* and *Charles* Counties, praying to levy on the taxable Inhabitants, at Two equal Assessments, £. 350 Current Money, to make an Enlargement of their Parish Church, was Read, and Leave given to bring in a Bill according to Prayer.

ORDERED, That *Mr. Beall*, *Mr. Stoddert*, *Mr. Murdock*, Major *Waring*, *Mr. J. Hall*, and *Col. Tilghman*, do prepare and bring in a Bill accordingly.

The Petition of *All-Faith* Parish in *St. Mary's* County, was Read and Rejected.

The Petition of *St. Andrew's* Parish in *St. Mary's* County, was Read; and referred to the Consideration of next Assembly.

The Petition of *All-Saints* Parish in *Frederick* County, was Read and Rejected.

The Petition of *Baltimore-Town*, in *Baltimore* County, was Read, and Leave given to bring in a Bill. ORDERED, That *Mr. Key*, *Mr. Johnson*, and *Col. Tilghman*, do prepare and bring in a Bill.

The House adjourns till 11 of the Clock Afternoon.
