So endeth this Session of Assembly, this 30th Day of *November*, in the Twenty-first Year of the Dominion of the Right Honourable FREDERICK absolute Lord and Proprietary of the Provinces of *Maryland and Avalan*, Lord Baron of *Baltimore*, &c. and in the Year of our Lord 1771
