By Mr. M'Neill, An act respecting the western limits of the state of Maryland and the dividing line and boundary between it and the commonwealth of Virginia.

By Mr. Fitzhugh, An act to establish a bank and incorporate a company under the name of The Washington County Bank in Washington county.

By Mr. Steuart of Baltimore, An additional supplement to an act, entitled, An act relating to the city of Baltimore. And, An act to incorporate The Female Penitents' Refuge in the city of Baltimore.
