

A supplement to the act, entitled, An act for draining a branch or swamp called Bee Tree Swamp, lying and being in Caroline county, passed December session eighteen hundred and twelve.

An act authorising the levy court of Caroline county to make the sheriffs of said county an allowance for ironing and unironing criminals committed to their custody.

An act to provide for the cession of territorial jurisdiction at Jane's Island, in Somerset county, and at Clay Island, in Dorchester county, for the erection of light houses, or at such other point or points in the said counties, or either of them, as may be selected by the proper officers of the government of the United States for the erection of the said light houses.

An act to authorise the building a bridge across the Sassafras river from Water-street, adjoining lot No. 26, in Frederick-town, in Cecil county, to James Mitchell's wharf adjoining the public landing in George-town, in Kent county.

An act to enable Charles Carroll, of Carrollton, to receive patents for two warrants of resurvey on certain lands heretofore conveyed in trust by him. And

An act authorising the trustees of primary schools in Queen-Anne's county to condemn ground for the purposes of building school houses thereon in said county; severally endorsed "will pass." Also

An act for the education of the indigent deaf and dumb of this state; endorsed "will unanimously pass." Also

An act for the relief of the creditors and infant devisees of Thomas Beall, of Samuel, late of Allegany county; endorsed "will pass with the proposed amendments;" which amendments were read the first, and by a special order the second time, and severally assented to.

An act to incorporate the Frederick-town Savings Institution.

An act to change the place of holding elections in the second election district of Anne-Arundel county.

An act to authorise the levy court of Prince-George's county to sell a lot of public land in the town of Upper Marlborough. And

An act to authorise the sale of a portion of the unsubscribed shares of stock reserved for the state in the Union Bank of Maryland; severally endorsed "will pass with the proposed amendment." The amendment proposed by the senate to each of the four last mentioned bills was read the first, and by a special order the second time, and assented to. Also
