The bill reported by Mr. Buskirk, entitled, *An act for the benefit of John Hogeland and Jonathan Hogeland, late of Allegany county, and for other purposes*, was taken up for consideration, by the Speaker, in just turn, conformably to the 40th rule of the house, and read the second time.

After some discussion, the question was put, Shall the said bill pass?

And it was resolved in the affirmative.

Mr. Lee asked and obtained leave to bring in a bill, entitled, *An act to amend an act, entitled, An act to incorporate a company to make a turnpike road from the line of the District of Columbia, where it crosses the post-road leading from George-town, to Frederick-town, through Montgomery and Frederick counties, to Frederick-town.*

And, on his motion, it was Ordered, That the committee on internal improvement be instructed to prepare and report said bill.

SATURDAY, February 28, 1829.

The house met. Were present, the same members as on yesterday.

The clerk having made some progress in reading the proceedings of yesterday,

On motion by Mr. Gantt, the further reading thereof was dispensed with.

On motion by Mr. M'Mahon of Allegany, (seconded by two other members who voted with him in the majority on the question, as required by the 28th rule of the house,) the house agreed to reconsider its decision of yesterday evening on the question then taken, which resulted in the passage, by this house, of the bill, entitled, *An act for the benefit of John Hogeland and Jonathan Hogeland, late of Allegany county, and for other purposes; and the said bill was then ordered to lie on the table.*

Mr. Shower presented a petition of sundry inhabitants of the town of Hampstead and its vicinity, in Baltimore county, praying for the revival of a supplement to an act, entitled, *An act authorising a lottery to raise a sum of money to purchase a lot of ground in Hampstead alias Coxe's-town,*
