

Sec. 26th. Strike out from the words, 'stock of,' in the 3th line to the word, 'with,' in the 10th line.

Sec. 27. After the word, 'corporation,' in the 2d line insert, 'not exempted by law.'

Sec. 28. In the 5th line strike out, 'or government securities.' After the word, 'all' in the 6th line insert, 'stock in.' At the end of the section, add the words, 'by every law of the state.'

Sec. 32. Strike out this section.

Sec. 34. After the word, 'in' in the 14th line strike out the words, 'under oath.'

Sec. 53. Add the following words, 'and whenever duties are herein required to be performed by the mayor and city council of Baltimore, the said mayor and city council, are hereby authorised and empowered to appoint such commissioners and assessors as shall be required for the execution of such duties.'

The said report was read, ordered to lie on the table, and to be printed.

Mr Done chairman of the committee on ways and means, to which the subject had been referred, reported the following resolutions, viz.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the net revenue received from the inspection of tobacco in the city of Baltimore, after the new edifice now building on Dugan's wharf, be finished and paid for, be and the same is hereby appropriated to the payment of the loans raised by the state for the purchase and erection of warehouses in said city, and the treasurer of the western shore is hereby authorised and directed, to pay any part of the said loan, which is redeemable at the pleasure of the state, out of any revenue thus accruing and remaining in the treasury after the said new warehouse is paid for.

Resolved, That the several states warehouses, in the city of Baltimore, be placed under the care of the several inspectors who are employed in them, and when any repairs shall be necessary in either of them, the inspector thereof shall cause the same to be made on the best practicable terms, and pay for the same out of any monies in their hands, and shall file the vouchers of any monies thus paid, supported by affidavit, with the treasurer of the western shore.

Resolved, That the care of all the property of the state in the said city, exclusive of the said warehouses, be placed under the care and superintendance of the state's wharfinger, who is authorised to rent the same on the best terms
