

Mr McMahon, from the select committee, to which had been referred the petition of sundry inhabitants of Allegany county, praying for an alteration of the law respecting the working of the public roads in said county, (presented to this house on the 19th instant,) delivered an unfavorable report thereon; which was twice read and concurred in.

Mr Wootton, from the select committee, to which the subject had been referred, reported a bill, entitled an act to alter and change the name of Henderson Magruder Williams, according to the will of Henderson Magruder late of Prince George's county, deceased.

Mr. Shriver from the select committee, to which the subject had been referred, reported a bill, entitled an act, to revive the act, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and twenty five, 'incorporating the Westminster School,' and for other purposes And,

Mr Smith from the select committee, appointed on leave granted for the purpose, reported a bill, entitled an act, for the relief of the legal representatives of William S. Morsell, late clerk of Calvert county court.

The three last mentioned bills were severally read the first time, and ordered to lie on the table.

Mr Buskirk rose in his place, and stated to the house, that the gentleman who had been attending as the counsel for judge Hanson, in the examination of witnesses before the house with reference to the report of the Committee on Grievances and Courts of Justice, recommending the removal of said judge from the Bench of the 6th Judicial District, had informed him, that his other professional engagements would render it inconvenient for him to resume his place in the house to day; and therefore requested a suspension for this day only, of further proceedings in that case.

Whereupon, the order of the day in regard to said report and the further examination of said witnesses, was postponed until Monday next.

Mr Irving, from the select committee, to which the subject had been referred, reported a bill, entitled an act, to change the place of holding the election in Dames Quarter District, in Somerset county; which bill being read the first time, was, on motion of Mr Done, read the second time, by a special order, passed without amendment and sent to the Senate for concurrence.
