On the order directing an enquiry into the expediency of placing the name of Mary Cheseldine, of Saint Mary's county, on the pension list; made on the 13th instant,

The favorable report of the select committee on the petition of James Gaskins, of the city of Baltimore, praying compensation for apprehending and bringing to justice, a certain Dixon, alias Wasers, who was tried and convicted in Talbot county court, and sent to the Maryland Penitentiary for five years, for kidnapping and taking away the slave of William Lowe, of said county; (made on the 13th instant,) was taken up for consideration, read the second time, concurred in, and the resolution therein contained assented to by the house, and sent to the Senate for concurrence.

The two several resolutions reported by Mr Done, chairman of the Joint Committee on the State Library, on the 9th and 16th instant; the one authorising the disposition of extra sets of the Laws of Maryland, including Kilty's Index, now in the state library, and the expenditure of the proceeds thereof in the purchase of other law books, for the use of said library; and the other authorising the exchange or other disposition of the extra sets of the History of England, now in the library, and the investment of the proceeds thereof in the purchase of other books suitable for the library, were taken up for consideration, severally read the second time, assented to by the house, and sent to the Senate for concurrence.

The bills of the following titles were taken up for consideration, in just turn, severally read the second time, passed, without amendment, and sent to the Senate for concurrence, viz:

A supplement to the act to provide for the public instruction of youth in Primary Schools, in Anne Arundel county. Reported by Mr Sellman on the 6th instant. And,

An act for the relief of Duncan Stone, of Kent county, an alien. Reported by Mr Hynson on the 10th instant

The bill reported by Mr Sellman on the 6th instant, entitled, an act to provide for rebuilding a certain bridge therein mentioned, was taken up for consideration, in just turn; when,

(On motion by Mr Sellman, it was again ordered to lie on the table.
