

and count them, and to report the result, retired to the committee room for that purpose; who, after a short time had elapsed, returned and reported, that of the sixty-nine ballots taken, George Howard, of John Eager, had thirty-five votes, and Samuel Moore had thirty four votes.

Whereupon, it was declared and resolved, That George Howard, of John Eager, having received a majority of the votes taken had been duly elected by this House a Director on the part of the State, in the Bank of Baltimore, for and during the current year, as prescribed by law.

The clerk of the Senate returned the bills and resolutions of this house, of the following titles.

An act to exempt certain property in the city of Baltimore from taxation

An act for the relief of the heirs of John Stevens.

An act to establish the grade of West Baltimore street, between Paca and Cove streets.

A supplement to the act to provide for the public instruction of youth in primary schools in Anne-Arundel county.

An act for the relief of Duncan Stone, of Kent county, an alien.

An act to authorise the levy court of Frederick county, to levy a sum of money for building a bridge over Katoc-tin creek, in said county; And,

An act to repeal a part of certain acts therein mentioned, severally endorsed, 'will pass.' Also,

An for the benefit of the devisees of Mary Millway, late of Somerset county, deceased.

An act relating to the public roads in Queen Anne's county. And,

An act to provide for the inspection of shingles at Port Deposit, in Cecil county, severally endorsed, 'will pass with the proposed amendments;' which amendments were read the first, and by special order, the second time, and severally assented to. Also,

An act to lay out and open a road from Harnes Old Field in Baltimore county, to Lisbon, in Anne-Arundel county; endorsed 'will pass with the proposed amendment,' which
