

*Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to each member of the Senate and House of Delegates, and their officers, who may be present when the session closes, the per diem allowance of two days after the session shall terminate.*

Which was read the first, and, by a special order the second time, assented to, and sent to the Senate for concurrence.

The clerk of the Senate returned the bills and resolutions of this house, of the following titles:

An Act for the relief of Elizabeth Martin, of the city of Baltimore; endorsed, '*will pass, with the proposed amendment.*'

Which amendment was read the first, and, by a special order, the second time, and assented to. Also,

Which amendments were read the first, and, by a special order, the second time, and severally assented to. Also,

A resolution requiring the Armourer at Annapolis, to deliver to Captain Basil Duke, of Calvert county, certain arms and accoutrements, therein mentioned.

A resolution requiring the Armourer at Annapolis, to deliver to William V. Buskirk, captain of the Allegany Rifle Company, certain arms therein mentioned.

A resolution, with its preamble, in favor of the State Librarian, increasing his salary; and,

A resolution to reimburse John Quynn, the money advanced for sawing wood, for the use of both houses, during the present session; severally endorsed, "assented to."

Ordered, That the said bills, with their respective amendments, and the said resolutions, be severally engrossed

The bill from the Senate, entitled, a supplement to the act, entitled, an act to regulate the inspection of Tobacco, was taken up for consideration.

The amendments reported on the 23d ult., by the select committee, to which said bill had been referred, were read the second time, and severally assented to.
