At the December Session of 1830.

MARYLAND, SC.

At a Session of the General Assembly of the State of Maryland, which was begun and held in the State-House, at the city of Annapolis, in the county of Anne-Arundel, on the last Monday, twenty-seventh day, of the month of December, in the year of our Lord one thousand, eight hundred and thirty, and in the fifty-fifth year of the Independence of the United States of America, conformably to the Constitution and form of government of the said State; the following proceedings took place in the House of Delegates, viz:

At twelve o'clock, M. of said day, On motion of Mr. Rogerson, the names of the gentlemen declared and returned to have been duly elected on the first Monday in October last, as Delegates to the General Assembly, for the respective Counties of the said State, and the Cities of Annapolis and Baltimore, were, as usual, called over by the Clerk of the last House of Delegates, from the official returns made by the Judges of Elections, and placed in his hands for that purpose, according to the seniority of said Counties and Cities, in the following order, to wit:—

From the County of Saint Mary's—Richard Thomas, John T. Hawkins, William J. Blakistone, and Stephen H. Gough, Esquires.

From the County of Kent.—Joseph Moffett, William W. Brown, Hugh Wallis and Bartis Piner, Esquires.

From the County of Anne Arundel.—Charles R. Stewart, Thomas Hood, Robert W. Kent, and Richard G. Stockett, Esquires.
