*Sheep:* leave for a bill to protect, 80; supplement to the act for the protection of, reported 144; amended and passed 184; sent to the senate 185; returned with amendments, which are assented to 350

*Sheriffs:* reports of money paid into the treasury by—see the several counties.

Of Calvert county, leave to report a bill allowing the late, further time to complete collections 26; reported, passed and sent to the senate 31; returned assented to 47.

Petition of, of Washington county, for additional allowance for the support of prisoners 28; bill reported 86; passed 99; sent to the senate 105; returned passed 187.

Leave to report a bill to allow R. C. Lusby, former, of Cecil county, further time to complete his collections 39; reported 51; passed 68; sent to the senate 69; returned rejected 89.
