Ordered, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore be, and he is hereby authorized to pay unto the several members of the present General Assembly, and the officers thereof, or to their respective orders, the several sums of money now due, or that may from time to time become due to them respectively, and for which they shall obtain certificates from the chairman of the committee on claims, of the present House of Delegates.

Mr. Johnson obtained leave to bring in a bill to be entitled, An act to incorporate the Jefferson Savings Institution.

Ordered, That Messrs. Johnson, Hammond and Schley, report the same.

Mr. Jenkins obtained leave to bring in a bill, to be entitled, A supplement to an act, entitled, An act to provide for the public printing of the State, passed at December session 1831, chapter 303.

Ordered, That Messrs. Jenkins, Brewer, and Hammond, report the same.
