

On motion by Mr. Jones, the house took up for consideration, the unfavorable report of the committee on pensions and revolutionary claims, upon the petition of Levin Willin, of Somerset county;

Which was read.

Mr. Jones then offered as a substitute for said report the following.

*Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore, pay out of any unappropriated money in the Treasury, to Levin Willin, senior, of Somerset county, a soldier of the revolutionary war, or to his order, during his life, in quarter yearly payments, a sum of money equal to the half pay of a private, in consideration of the services, rendered by him, during the war of the revolution.*

Which was read.

On the question being put, will the house adopt the substitute.

It was resolved in the affirmative.

The said resolution was then read the second time and assented to.

The bill reported by Mr Ely, entitled, An act to incorporate the Patapsco Savings Institution, at Ellicott's Mills, was taken up for consideration.

On motion by Mr. Teackle, said bill was amended by inserting after the word "place," in the second section, tenth line, the following; "Provided, that such election shall be made within one month from the expiration of the term for which the preceding directors shall have been elected."

On motion by Mr. Teackle, the fourth section of said bill was amended, by striking out from the words "by-laws," in the eighth line, to the end of said section, and inserting in lieu thereof the following.

Provided, That nothing contained in this act shall be construed to authorise the corporation hereby intended to be created, to issue any bill, note or other device, in the nature of a Bank note.

On motion by Mr. Teackle, said bill was further amended by inserting as the eighth section of the bill, the following.

Sec. 8. *And be it enacted, That the concerns of the institution hereby intended to be incorporated, shall be at all times subject to the inspection of the Treasurer of the Western Shore, or of such other officer or agent of the state as may be selected for that purpose; by either branch of the Legislature.*
