SATURDAY, February 2nd, 1833.

The house met; the same members present as on yesterday. The proceedings of yesterday were read;

Mr. Jenkins presented a petition of the widow and heirs of William Warner, late of the city of Baltimore deceased, praying the passage of an act to authorise them to mortgage certain property therein mentioned; which was read and referred to Messrs. Jenkins, Harper and Turner.

Mr. Harding presented a petition of sundry citizens of Montgomery county, praying an act to incorporate the Rockville Savings Institution; which was read and referred to Messrs. Harding, Willson and Gittings.

Mr. Forwood presented a petition of sundry inhabitants of Harford county, praying for a law to direct the commissioners to levy money to build a bridge over Deer creek, at Clarks Ford; which was read and referred to Messrs. Forwood, Johns and Sutton.

Mr. Harper presented a petition of the licensed pilots of the State of Maryland, counter to that of certain owners and masters of coasting vessels of this State, praying that no alteration may be made in the law relating to Pilots; which was read and referred to the committee already appointed on that subject.
