Mr. Jones moved to amend the 5th amendment reported by the committee, by inserting after the word "State," in the first line, the words "or in the President of the United States,"

On motion by Mr. Harris, the fifth amendment was amended, by adding at the end thereof the words "and to protect the persons and property of the citizens thereof."

Mr Jenkins moved to amend the twelfth resolution, by adding at the end thereof the following—
