

Mr. Ely presented a petition of William Scharf of Baltimore county, praying relief as therein mentioned;

Which was read, and referred to Messrs. Ely, Holmes and Worthington.

Mr. Chandler presented a petition of Henry W. Carvill, and George S. Hollyday, Executors of John W. Carvill, praying to be allowed to introduce certain slaves into this state;

Which was read and referred to the committee on the coloured population.

Mr. Ellicott presented a petition of Charles W. Dorsey and others, relating to the construction of a bridge over the Patapsco Falls at Ellicott's old upper Mills;

Which was read and referred to Messrs. Ellicott, Duvall, of Anne Arundel, Burgess, Turner and Worthington.

Mr. Hollman presented a petition of sundry citizens of Washington county, praying for a law authorising them to make a turnpike road, in said county;

Which was read and referred to the committee already appointed on that subject.

Mr. Edelen presented a petition of George G. Coe, of Prince George's county, praying the redress of grievances therein mentioned;

Which was read and referred to the committee on the militia.

Mr. Slicer presented a petition of sundry citizens of Allegany county, praying that the Legislature will take such measures, compatible with the public faith, as will compel the Canal Company to permit on the terms recommended by the resolution of the last General Assembly, the passage of the Rail-road through the narrow passes specified;

Which was read and referred to the committee on internal improvement.

Mr. Slicer, presented a petition of sundry citizens of Allegany county, praying a law may pass authorising the United States to make a partial change in the location of a part of the national road, in said county, and complete the making of the same;

Which was read and referred to the consideration of the Senate.

Mr. Bruce presented a petition of George Calmes, and others, citizens of Allegany county, praying that the act creating a medical and Chirurgical Faculty in the State of Maryland, so far as the same relates to Allegany county, may be repealed;
