

And further Resolved, that the Levy Court of said county, be, and they are hereby authorised and required to levy, on the assessable property of said county, such sum or sums of money, as may be necessary for the use of the said Register of Wills, in performing the duties enjoined upon him by the first resolution, the cost of binding said records to be included, the same to be collected and paid over as other county charges are—provided, that the whole amount of money thus levied shall not exceed the sum of seventy-five dollars.
