

section, the following; Provided, that such election shall be made within one month from the expiration of the term for which the preceeding directors shall have been elected.

On motion by Mr. Teackle, said bill was further amended, by adding at the end of the third section, the following—

Provided, that nothing contained in this act shall be construed to authorise the corporation hereby intended to be chartered, to issue any bill, note, or other device in the nature of a bank note.

On motion by Mr. Teackle, the proviso to the fourth section of said bill was stricken out.

On motion by Mr. Teackle, said bill was further amended by striking out the 9th and 10th sections, and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

Sec 9. And be it enacted, that the concerns of the institution hereby intended to be incorporated, shall be all times subject to the inspection of the Treasurer of the Western Shore, or of such other officer or agent of the State as may be selected for that purpose by either branch of the Legislature.

Sec. 10. And be it enacted, that this act shall continue and be in force until the year 1845, and until the end of the next session of the General Assembly which shall happen thereafter.

The said bill was then read the second time as amended and passed.

On motion by Mr. Hammond, the house took up for consideration the amendments proposed by the Senate, to the bill, entitled, An act to allow additional compensation to John P. Schyler and for other purposes.

The said amendments were then read the second time, severally "assented to," and the bill ordered to be engrossed.

The bill reported by Mr. Edelen, entitled, An act relating to certain trespasses upon real estate.

The bill reported by Mr. Ely, entitled, An act to incorporate the Oakland Academy in Baltimore county.

The bill reported by Mr. Compton, entitled, An act giving compensation to jurors, in cases of forcible entry and detainer;

And, the bill from the Senate, entitled, An act to repeal an act, entitled, An act for the encouragement of an Iron Manufacture within this province;

Were severally taken up for consideration, read the second time, passed, and sent to the Senate.
