Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That his excellency the Governor, be and he is hereby requested to procure two suitable swords, appropriately ornamented, and present one of them to Col. Nathan Towson, of the United States Army, and the other to Capt. John Gallagher, of the United States Navy; on behalf of the general assembly of the State of Maryland, as a testimony of the admiration and gratitude of this their native state, for their distinguished gallantry, and highly valuable services during the last war with Great Britain.

And be it further resolved, That the treasurer of the western shore be, and he is hereby directed to pay to the order of the Governor, such sum as may be necessary to carry into effect the foregoing resolution out of any unappropriated money in the treasury.
