So the 7th section was stricken out.

The hour having arrived for taking up the orders of the day, the house proceeded to take up for consideration the bill reported by Mr. Palmer, from the committee on the constitution, entitled, an act to alter and amend the constitution of this state, being the first order of the day.

When on motion by Mr Pratt, the same was postponed.

On motion by Mr Pratt, the House then resumed the consideration of the bill reported by him, Entitled, a supplement to the act, to establish a Bank in the District of Columbia;

On motion by Mr. Pratt the said bill was further amended by inserting after the word "State," in the 1st. line 3d. page, the following words 'until the year 1845, and after 1845 such a bonus as the Legislature may at that time impose on the other Banks of this State.

Mr. Willson moved the following as a substitute for the amendment heretofore proposed by him;

*And be it enacted,* That nothing contained in this act shall be construed, as to authorise the location of said bank or any branch thereof, or any house for banking purposes within the city of Baltimore. or on the Eastern Shore.

Which having been read the question was put, will the House adopt the substitute;
