FRIDAY, March 14th, 1834.

The house met. Present the same members as on yesterday, except Mr. Berry.

On motion by Mr. Bruff, the rule which requires the journal of proceedings of the preceding day to be read was suspended, and the reading of said journal was dispensed with.

And, the bill entitled, an act to repeal an act for the establishment and support of public free schools, in the first Election District of Baltimore county, and the several supplements thereto;
